

## Consultation Appointment Confirmation

## Dear Patient,

Thank you for your interest in vision correction options at the New England Eye Center. We are looking forward to seeing you for your complete dilated exam. You are scheduled to be seen at the 260 Tremont Street location, 11<sup>th</sup> floor, Boston, MA. 02111. The contact phone is 617-636-3360.

It is extremely important you remember to remove your contact lenses <u>two weeks prior to your surgery</u> and at <u>least 5 days prior to this appointment</u>. **Please remember to remove your lenses.** 

## In preparation for your visit:

New England Eye Center has transitioned to electronic health records. Our registration processes have changed. If this is your first appointment, the visit may take a bit longer than usual. Please plan on being with us for a minimum of two hours. You will be meeting with our Refractive Coordinator, along with our team of Technicians and Optometrists who specialize specifically in vision correction options. The cost of your visit will be \$150 dollars and will be applied to your procedure fees if you proceed.

During this visit <u>we will be dilating your eyes</u>. After your exam your eyes will be sensitive to light and you will find it difficult to read or use the computer for the remainder of the day. If you do not have sunglasses, we will provide you with shaded inserts to keep the sunlight or glare from bothering you.

This visit is your opportunity to have a <u>complete dilated eye</u> and learn about your options. You will be informed of pricing and payment plans and most importantly, if you are ready to take the next step to planning your vision correction surgery, we will schedule you to meet with one of our highly experienced <u>Cornea Specialists</u>.

- <u>All patients are now required to pre-register with TUFTS</u> prior to their first appointment. You will need your picture ID and health insurance cards upon arrival. While not all visits are covered by insurance, TUFTS still requires us to collect health insurance information to create your medical record. If this is your first appointment with us, please pre-register by calling 617-636-8600.
- Attached is the link for <u>your paperwork</u>. This should be completed prior to your visit. You may bring it with you or email it in advance at <u>lsymanski@tuftsmedicalcenter.org</u>.
- If you have your contact lens box or prescription, please bring it with you along with your most current pair of glasses.
